

Dr. Monte C. Grisé

Monte C. Grisé is the Director of Bands at Minnesota State University Moorhead where he conducts the MSUM Wind Symphony, Chamber Winds and Pep Band. He also teaches conducting and secondary instrumental methods. In addition, Grisé also serves as the Applied Saxophone Instructor and Music Education Coordinator.

Prior to his appointment at MSUM, Dr. Grisé was the Associate Director of Bands, Director of the Bengal Marching Band and Applied Saxophone Instructor at Idaho State University in Pocatello, Idaho. He also held positions as the Director of Bands at Capital High School in Helena, Montana, and 5-12 Band and Choir Director in Manhattan, Montana.

Grisé earned a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Conducting and Pedagogy from James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia, a Master of Music in Performance and Pedagogy from Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, Oklahoma, and a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Montana State University – Bozeman.
