Graydon is currently a member of the Winnipeg Jazz Collective and the R&B/swing band, "Chameleon". He has presented clinics and workshops with many different schools and other settings all over Manitoba and has maintained a private studio of drum students for the last 14 years. Graydon has performed in numerous festivals and concert series across the prairies such as the Clear Lake Chamber Festival, Moose Jaw Band Festival, the Winnipeg and Saskatchewan Jazz festivals, Nu Sounds Series, and the Brandon University Pro Series with the likes of Michael Cain, Greg Gatien, Dean McNeil, and the Nuphunk Orchestra.
