

Timothy Wisdom is a woodwind player with a focus on clarinet, bassoon, and flute. He has a wide range of performance experience including classical orchestral literature, musical theater, and a variety of other genres such as jazz, baroque, and polka. Most recently he collaborated with Argentinian tango pianist Pablo Ziegler of the Piazzolla quintet. He has played with the Fargo Moorhead Symphony and Fargo Moorhead Opera. Since earning a performance degree in 2013 he has regularly appeared as a chamber musician on a variety of student and faculty recitals at North Dakota State University and his alma mater Concordia College in Moorhead, MN. He organized and managed the Zephyr Wind Quintet from 2015-2016 and performed with the Blue Boys Dance Band—a polka band active across Minnesota from 2011-2014.

Timothy has taught private lessons ranging from beginners to undergraduates and is in his second year as bassoon and clarinet faculty member of the International Music Camp. In 2016 he served as low reed section coach for Minnesota Music Educators Association's high school all state band camp. He currently attends the Boston Conservatory at Berklee where he is pursuing a multiple woodwind master's degree. As an active freelance musician in Boston Tim has performed with the Boston Philharmonic *Crescendo* program and various musical theater companies in the greater metropolitan area.
