



Musician and educator Craig Goettle currently serves as the 6th Grade Band Director and the 7th/8th Grade Choir Instructor for the St. Mary's Academy in Bismarck, ND. He also serves as the director for the St. Mary's Central High School "Hammerhead" Steel Band, assists with the 7th and 8th grade bands, teaches trombone lessons at the high school, and directs the trombone choir. His diverse performance background and education in band, choir, jazz band, vocal jazz, chamber music, and steel band have developed him into a well-rounded educator for the students in the Light of Christ Schools. Craig also retains a position as a part-time music director at Spirit of Life Catholic Church in Mandan, ND.
