

Albert Nguyen is the Director of Bands at the University of Memphis. His responsibilities include overseeing all aspects of the university bands, conducting the Wind Ensemble, leading the graduate wind conducting program, and serving as the director of the Memphis Music Camp. He also teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in music education. Prior to this position, Dr. Nguyen served as the Assistant Director of Bands and the Director of Athletic Bands at the University of Memphis. He began his professional teaching career in Arkansas as the Director of Bands at Morrilton High School and maintains his connection to the public schools by frequently serving as an adjudicator, clinician, and guest conductor.

Dr. Nguyen holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Music Education from Arkansas Tech University and the Master of Music and Doctorate of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting from The University of Texas at Austin. He is a member of *Kappa Kappa Psi*, *Tau Beta Sigma*, College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Educators, and is a contributing author in the GIA publication *Teaching Music through Performance in Band*.
