Paradis has exhibited her digital media artwork in galleries throughout Manitoba including the Winnipeg Art Gallery, the Planetarium, the Plug Inn Institute of Contemporary Art, the Rachel Browne Theatre, Cinematheque, Videopool, Ace Art, ACI Manitoba, as well as the Edge Gallery and Urban Arts Centre.

Paradis has also recently curated a collaborative digital media arts exhibition in Winnipeg for Nuit Blanche called Neon Noir, which included Augmented Reality, Virtual Reality, video projections, interactive art installations, and live electronic music.
