

# Digital Photography

Please bring the following items with you to camp:

- ◆ Digital camera
- ◆ Owner's manual for camera (downloaded copy if necessary)
- ◆ Tripod, if available
- ◆ Empty Memory card (or two)
- ◆ Extra camera batteries and/or charger
- ◆ Cords, cables, and/or card reader (for uploading to computer)
- ◆ Jump drive (minimum 16GB) and/or blank CD/DVD for saving photos
- ◆ Storage or carrying bag for camera and gear
- ◆ Neck strap
- ◆ Pocket folders or portfolio (for prints)
- ◆ Journal or notebook
- ◆ Back-up camera, if you have one, in case of battery failure or camera damage.
- ◆ Flashlight with fresh batteries, glow sticks, or light pen for nighttime light graffiti.
- ◆ Small object from home, for example LEGOs or a Matchbox car.
