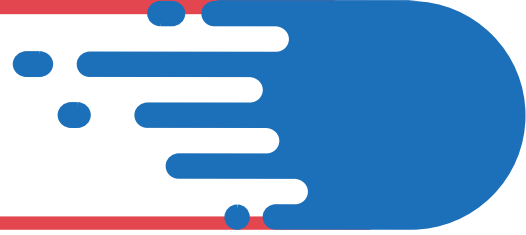

# CAMP PROGRAMS



Campers in **BAND** or **JAZZ BAND** will participate in full rehearsals, sectionals, master classes, fundamental classes (music theory), and can sign up to be in chamber ensembles, Jazz Bands (non-Jazz weeks), or Jazz Combos when they arrive at camp. Advanced musicians may be asked to also perform in the honor ensemble. Private lessons with professional artists are available in sets of two. Love to play or play more than one instrument? Consider attending for multiple weeks of **Band**, or come back for **Jazz Band** during Session Five!

**CHOIR** campers will sing in large ensembles with daily rehearsals and participate in technique classes, sectionals, fundamental classes (music theory), and a variety of other vocal ensembles. Select campers may be asked to sing in the Chamber Choir or participate in the Piano/Voice Collaborative Workshop. Is pop music a favorite of yours? You can join a **Pop Choir** for no additional charge as part of your time at camp. Private lessons with professional artists are available in sets of two. If you want to come for more than one week for voice, **Musical Theatre** is held during Session Three and **Vocal Jazz** is held during Session Five.

Campers in the **ORCHESTRA** program are placed in one of three large orchestras depending on age. Advanced musicians may be asked to perform with the Honor Orchestra. In addition to large group rehearsals, campers fill their day with fundamental classes (music theory), sectionals, master classes, and chamber ensembles. Campers interested in fiddling can come to camp for our **Fiddle** session. Violin players attending camp for the **Orchestra**

program can participate in **Fiddle** at no additional charge. Private lessons with professional artists are available in sets of two. Woodwind and brass players interested in playing for the orchestras must submit an audition recording by May 1st. Audition materials and information are available on the IMC website.

In **WORLD PERCUSSION**, campers will learn about the role of percussion in West Africa, the Caribbean, South America, Trinidad and Tobago, and the Middle East. The International Music Camp is home to the Matthew Miller Memorial World Percussion Collection, a unique collection of high-quality instruments from around the world including our newest addition—steel pans! This program is open to all students and adults with musical backgrounds who want to learn more about World Music.

The **PIANO** and **PIANO/ORGAN** programs include daily classes (beginning through advanced sections) in ensemble performance (duets), musicianship, and music history, as well as an evening piano seminar. The week ends with a solo recital. Two half hour private lessons are included in the **Piano** program fees and two one hour lessons are included in the **Piano/Organ** program fees. **Piano/Organ** campers will take their lessons on the Organ instead of Piano. **Piano** campers can sign up for an additional set of two lessons. The program is open to students ages 10 through adult with at least two years of piano experience. The **Piano/Organ** program is great for students who already know how to play the piano and are interested in learning about the Organ.



Develop skills in acting and performing in our **THEATRE ARTS** programs. The **Drama** and **Musical Theatre** programs offer week long studies of stage movement, vocal techniques, production methods, and a range of light to advanced choreography. A performance on Saturday marks the end of both programs. Consider staying both sessions for more acting experience!



Our physically intense **DANCE** program is designed for hard-working dancers with at least two years of dance experience. Our Dance streams are composed of combinations of **Ballet/Modern** and **Jazz/Tap/Theatre**. **Dance** is offered in one or two consecutive sessions.

The **VISUAL ART** programs at the INTERNATIONAL MUSIC CAMP offer opportunities for campers to study with outstanding artist-teachers who are experts in their disciplines. If you are a middle school student looking for your first IMC experience, check out **Middle School Art** during Session One. Our **Digital Photography** course takes place during Session Two. The **Basic Art** program is designed for young artists, and provides many different artistic experiences and media and is offered during Session Four with **Drawing**. Specialty programs are offered in **Painting**, **Sculpture**, and **Cartooning** during Session Six. An art exhibition caps off each week. **Professional Development for Educators** is offered too!



Are you interested in exploring ways to express yourself through writing or understanding more about the creative process? If so, check out our **CREATIVE ARTS** programs! **Creative Writing** is offered during Session Two and the **Music Composition** program takes place during Session Three. The artist-teachers in these programs guide campers to the next creative level through exciting and interesting activities.

**AND THERE'S MORE!** INTERNATIONAL MUSIC CAMP also offers **Garage Band**, **Audio Technology**, **Drumline**, **Mallet Percussion**, **Handbells**, **Harp**, **Guitar**, and the **University Preparatory Program!** For additional information check out [internationalmusiccamp.com](http://internationalmusiccamp.com)!

Teachers! Design your very own **PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT** experience this summer! Work with leading guest conductors, active professional artists, and energetic teachers who are eager to share their expertise with you. Full-Week 2-credit sessions are also available. Sessions run Sunday evening through Wednesday, or Sunday through Saturday. Contact the IMC office for more details. Are you over 21? Join us for four days of **ADULT CAMP** and reconnect with old friends, continue to grow in your skills, and learn some new skills along the way! Adult campers can choose to participate in a variety of programs including **Bands**, **Mixed Choir**, **Orchestras**,

**Brass Band**, **Women's and Men's Barbershop**, **World Percussion**, **Harp**, **Handbells**, and **Studio Art**. Can't select just one? You don't have to! Adult campers create their own schedule that allows them to do multiple programs at the same time.

# CAMP INFORMATION

**WHO MAY ATTEND?** Middle school through high school students and adults from any country with experience in a Fine Art. Ages or grade levels are listed on the website and registration form for each program.



**TRANSPORTATION** - Campers have many options to get to IMC. Families should plan to carpool or drive their campers to IMC. Those traveling by bus or train may be met at stations in Brandon, MB or Rugby, ND. Those traveling by air may be met at airports in Winnipeg or Brandon, MB or Minot, ND (please contact the IMC office prior to purchasing tickets). A shuttle fee is charged both ways for those using bus, train, or air transportation. Arrangements **MUST** be made in advance, and parents must confirm travel itineraries with us two weeks before travel.

**PASSPORTS** are not required to get in and out of the International Peace Garden, but they are the recommended form of identification. If you do not already have a passport, you will need a birth certificate (everyone in the vehicle) and photo ID (if you are 16 or older) to return to your country of origin upon leaving IMC and the Peace Garden. Each passenger in every vehicle is expected to present these documents. This special exemption applies only to the Dunseith and Boissevain ports of entry. Passports are required for US citizens to travel to Canada and for Canadian citizens to enter the US.



A complete **INFORMATION PACKET** will be sent by mail to each individual at the end of May. The packet includes important information about your camp session including arrival details and what to bring. This information may also be found online. **IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED A PACKET TWO WEEKS BEFORE YOUR SESSION PLEASE PHONE THE CAMP.**

**UPON ARRIVAL** - All campers will go through Registration from 12:30-3pm (Sessions 1-6), where they will receive schedules, dorm assignments, badges, and other important information. Final payments may also be made at Registration.



**HOUSING** - Campers are housed in modern open dormitories at IMC, many of which are air-conditioned. All youth campers are supervised **AT ALL TIMES** by adult counselors. Dorm assignments are made on the day the registration and deposit are received. Most dorms have two beds per room and roommates are assigned at random unless a roommate request is indicated on the registration form. Roommate requests will be held for only two weeks. All dorms are single sex and no private rooms are available.

**MEDICAL SERVICES** - Each camper is required to have a health form completed and on file upon arrival at camp. A nurse is on duty at all times Sessions 1-6. Hospitals and clinics in both North Dakota and Manitoba are accessible.



**MEALS** are served cafeteria style. Every effort is made to provide nourishing, well-balanced meals for all students and staff. Campers with special dietary needs (vegetarian, gluten-free, etc.) should contact the camp at least two weeks prior to arrival. Pop, juice, and other snacks are available for purchase at the concession stand during free time. The International Music Camp is **NUT FREE** due to staff and campers who have life-threatening allergies to nuts and nut oils. Please **DO NOT** bring any nut products to IMC!



**RECREATION** - Recreational times are scheduled each day in the late afternoon and evening. Recreation includes such activities as dances, movies, camper talent nights, volleyball, soccer, basketball, faculty recitals, and concerts.

**CONCERTS** - Final performances or exhibitions are presented at the conclusion of each session. They are open to the public and are free of charge. All campers **MUST** remain for the final performance or production of their program.

The **BASIC FEE** includes housing, meals, and tuition. Registrations are accepted on a space-available basis. **EARLY REGISTRATION IS RECOMMENDED. A \$150 USD registration deposit for each session enrolled, payable to the INTERNATIONAL MUSIC CAMP, must accompany all registration forms.** The deposit will be applied towards the total fee for the session. The balance of the fee is payable upon registering at the camp on Sunday, or may be prepaid by sending payment to the **INTERNATIONAL MUSIC CAMP**. Payments received in CAD will be applied at the current exchange rate the day your fees are received. Visa and MasterCard are accepted but check or cash is preferred. If you want to pay by credit card over the phone, please call the **INTERNATIONAL MUSIC CAMP** with your card information. You may also register online at [www.internationalmusiccamp.com](http://www.internationalmusiccamp.com).

### CANCELLATIONS

- Campers canceling before May 15 will be refunded all but \$35 processing fee.
- Campers canceling after May 15, and before noon CST on the day their session begins, will be refunded all but the \$150 deposit.
- **NO REFUNDS** will be made starting at noon CST the day each session begins!
- A canceled registration deposit may be transferred to a student not already registered minus a \$10 processing fee.
- Campers who receive a full scholarship and cancel their registration will still be responsible for the \$35 processing fee before May 15 or the \$150 deposit after May 15.

### LESSONS

Lessons will be limited to one set for the following programs: Middle School Band (Session 1), Middle School Choir (1), Musical Theatre (3), Garage Band (3), Guitar (4), Piano/Organ (4), Jazz Bass (5).

### SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are often available through various community resources. Additional scholarship information can be found on our website. The International Music Camp is able to offer a limited number of need based scholarships for students to attend camp.
