This audition will be held on the first day of camp to place you within classes for the week. Everyone will be involved with workshop classes and musical numbers. This is just a way for the faculty to get to know you and place you within a performance group. **Please do not prepare a different song other than the pieces listed below.**

### **Choose one song to prepare for your audition on Sunday.**

**All That's Known (Boys)** - This song is sung by Melchior, who is a brilliant teen stuck in a very strict school. He is questioning his teachers, the school, and the world as to why he has to learn this way.

**How Lucky You Are (Boys or Girls)** - This song is sung by the Cat in the Hat (who can be played by a male or female) who is trying to cheer up the whining Mayzie and remind her of the good things in life.

**And All That Jazz (Girls)** - This song is sung by Velma at the opening of the show, setting the world of corruption, greed, and violence in Chicago's 1920's Jazz Age.

**Is it Really Me? (Girls)** - This song is sung by the main lead female character, Lizzie, who thinks she is plain. However, a mysterious man named Starbuck comes to town and tells her she is beautiful. This song is her discovering her beauty.

### **Things to Bring -**

1. **Shoes that you can move in.** This means no flip-flops, boots or heels.
2. **Clothes you can move in for rehearsals.** Please do not wear jewelry, as that may interfere with your movement/activity. Shorts/pants/skirts are fine, but remember you will be moving around.  
*\*You do not want to have to keep adjusting your clothing as you perform. Please no low-cut jeans or pants or excessively revealing clothing. Wear garments that won't make you self-conscious about what people might accidentally see!*
3. **Black clothing bottoms and a solid bright top (no writing or pictures) to perform in.** This may be any combination of shorts, shirts, skirts, pants, or a dress. This is also what you will wear for pictures.
4. **A 3-ring binder that is at least 1" thick.** This will hold your music for the week and is a necessity!
5. **Other fun clothing accessories or props.** If you have a favorite hat, boa, scarf, or other item you think you might possibly like to have, please feel free to bring it. We may or may not use the item in the final performance. This is completely optional and please do not bring more than 2 items or anything that may break or is valuable.
6. **Multiple PENCILS with good Erasers.** Or money to purchase pencils at the Allegro Shop.
