

Dr. Marla Fogderud, soprano, is an Associate Professor of Music at Northern State University in Aberdeen, SD, where she teaches voice and opera-related courses. A native of North Dakota, she is a regular performer in the region. She specializes in Norwegian art song, and has presented many recitals, lectures, and workshops on this topic across the United States as well as in Norway, Germany, and France. Fogderud is a founder and current president of the Edvard Grieg Society of the Dakotas, a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the music of Norway's most famous composer. Her latest project is an edited collection of songs by another Norwegian composer, Halfdan Kjerulf.
