

Passport & Travel Information

ALL IMC CAMPERS, EMPLOYEES, VISITORS & FAMILIES:



Passports are not required to get in and out of the International Peace Garden, but are the recommended form of identification. If you do not already have a passport, you will need a copy of your birth certificate (everyone in the vehicle) and a photo ID (if you are 16 or older) to return to your country of origin upon leaving IMC and the Peace Garden. Each passenger in every vehicle are expected to present these documents. This special exemption applies only to the Dunseith and Boissevain ports of entry. Passports will be required for US citizens to travel to Canada and for Canadians to enter the US.

International Travel for US and Canadian Residents

US Residents wanting to visit Canada and Canadians wanting to visit the US must check to see what the entry requirements are for each country. IMC does NOT have the capability or ability to assist with any testing for international travel.

ATTENTION CANADIAN RESIDENTS: Visiting the International Peace Garden is considered international travel. Before returning to Canada, you MUST use ArriveCAN (free App or website) to submit mandatory information regardless of your vaccination status or how long you've been away.

- **Travellers who are not fully vaccinated or who do not use the ArriveCan app are required to take a test on-arrival and on day 8, and to immediately quarantine for 14 days once leaving the International Peace Garden.**
- Travellers returning to Canada after visiting the International Peace Garden do not need to take a pre-entry COVID-19 test as long as their travel outside of Canada was only to the International Peace Garden. Fully vaccinated travellers arriving in Canada at any port of entry will not require a pre-entry test.
- Fully vaccinated travellers may be randomly selected for on-arrival testing.

The best way to ensure you fulfill the necessary requirements is filling out the information on ArriveCAN BEFORE you arrive at the International Peace Garden. As long as the departure date is correct, the information is submitted, and you have an arrival receipt, you will be set. Do not stress about putting the correct hour of the day for your departure time - that can be a guess.
