

Timothy Nelson is currently Principal Violist with the Fargo Moorhead Symphony and the orchestra teacher at Fargo South High School. He received a BM degree from the University of Wisconsin in Superior, and an MM degree from the Juilliard School, with emphasis in viola performance. For the ten years preceding coming to the Fargo Moorhead area, he was principal violist with the Arkansas Symphony in Little Rock, and violist in the Quapaw String Quartet, the members of which formed the full-time salaried core of the Arkansas Symphony. Mr. Nelson has played in the viola sections of many orchestras, including the Duluth Superior Symphony, the Madison (Wisconsin) Symphony, the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra and the Queens Philharmonic.
