The harp program welcomes campers of all levels and abilities, though rhythm and note-reading experience is highly recommended for the week-long session. Within the class lessons, there will be presentations, collaborations with other instruments, and exploratory sessions in harp literature, technique, improvisation, and more. Campers can expect to play in a harp ensemble and work on music in a variety of musical styles and genres with music provided at least one month in advance of camp arrival. Prior preparation is expected.

Campers are strongly encouraged to bring their own harp, either pedal or lever, as well as the following items: a tuner, tuning key, spare strings, bench, stand, and any solo music they wish to work on in lessons.

For those who need to rent an instrument, our instructor, Jaclyn Wappel, has a limited number of lever harps available for a one-time weekly fee of \$100. Please contact jaclyn.wappel@gmail.com for additional details.
