Please prepare and memorize **ONE** of the musical theatre audition cuts from the list below prior to coming to camp.

This audition will be held on the first day of camp to place you within classes for the week. Everyone will be involved with workshop classes and musical numbers. This is just a way for the faculty to get to know you and place you within a performance group. **Please do not prepare a different song other than the pieces listed below.**

Choose one song to prepare for your audition on Sunday.

The songs are divided into high voice and low voice rather than the character's gender, so feel free to choose the song that best fits your voice.

Broadway Baby - Low Voice

Any Dream Will Do - High Voice

Pulled - High Voice

Chillin' the Regrets - Low Voice

Things to Bring -

1. **Close-toed shoes.** Sneakers and dance shoes are preferred. Please no sandals, flip-flops, boots, heels, or crocs. Also, no bare feet or socks-only allowed on stage.
2. **Clothing you can move in at rehearsal.** We rehearse all day, and many times we may be getting down on the floor and stretching, so be mindful of that. Suggestions for clothing include athletic shorts, leggings, tee shirts, tank tops. If you're someone that can do gymnastics moves and feel comfortable with that, we may incorporate that, so be mindful of having a shirt that is long enough to tuck in. Please avoid short shorts, jeans, and clothing that is hard to move in.
3. **Black clothing bottoms and a solid bright top (no writing or pictures) to perform in.** This may be any combination of shorts, shirts, skirts, pants, or a dress. This is also what you will wear for pictures.
4. **A 3-ring binder that is at least 1" thick.** This will hold your music for the week and is a necessity!
5. **Multiple PENCILS with good Erasers.** Or money to purchase pencils at the Allegro Shop. Writing in pen on music is not allowed, so only pencils are allowed.
6. **WATER BOTTLE!** Rehearsals can be intense and hydration is vital.

The final performance will be on Saturday at 2:00 pm
