Mrs. Warren's bands consistently earned Superior ratings and Best in Class Awards. The bands performed in the London Parade and the Fiesta Bowl Parade. The band was also featured at the AMEA Conference. She served as President of AMEA, District Chairman, President-elect of the Alabama Bandmasters Association and West Region Band Representative of NDMEA. Becky is a member of Phi Beta Mu Chapters RHO and Alpha Gamma where she serves as Past President. She was awarded the Citation of Excellence by the NBA and Teacher of the Year in Ft. Payne. She received the 2021 NDMEA Distinguished Service Award and the 2025 NDBDA Distinguished Service Award.

Mrs. Warren continues to serve the band world as a clinician, adjudicator, and guest conductor. She currently serves as a founding advisor for the NASSB: National Association of Small School Bands. She has presented 4 clinics at the Midwest Band Clinic and serves as a contributing editor to The Instrumentalist magazine.
